Survey by ASW Jan/Feb 2018

The Survey is planned to take place between Friday Jan 12th and February 15th, but is subject to landowner and weather dictats.

There will be **rolling presentations on the nature and objectives of the project** to all interested parties [landowners, sponsors, HLHS members, villagers and local officials/organisations/societies]. These will include induction briefings to volunteers helping with the survey. **Timing will be on January 11th between 4.30 pm and 7 pm, at 4.45, 5.45 and 6.30 at the Kenyon Hall. [4 on map]**

Volunteers are sought to help with the marking out of survey grids, magnetometry walking and resistivity walking. Full training will be provided by ASW [Archaeological Survey West]. **It is stressed that volunteers should have NO METAL on their person, including mobile phone, coins, jewellery and implants.**

Survey days will start at 9.15 am and end at 4.00 pm (subject to weather conditions). Daily plans to be announced each morning.

Meeting Point: at junction of Chester Lane and Sewage Works Lane (SJ 405 544). If you have a car, park it in the village car park – see map for walking route to meeting point.

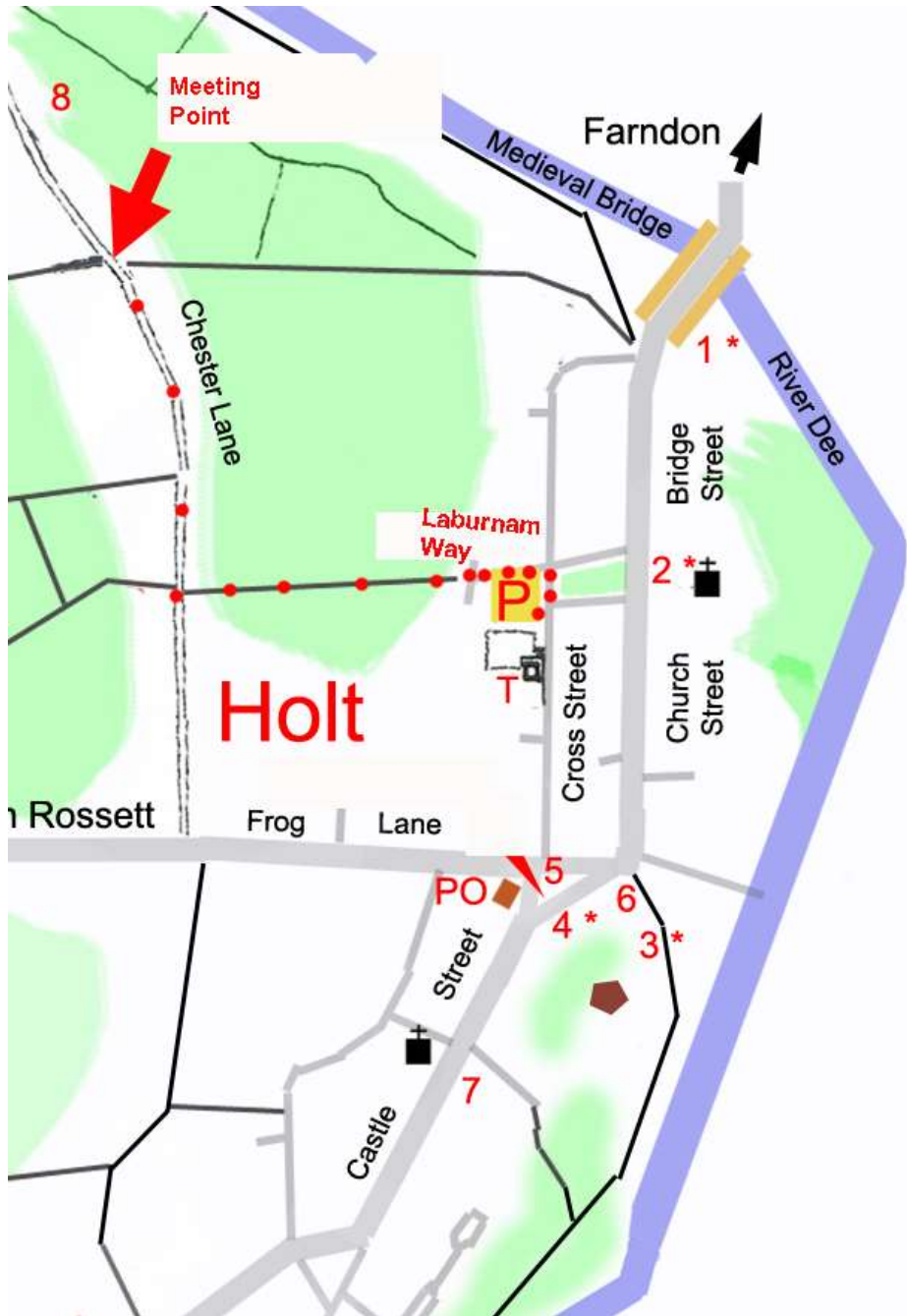

Directions to Meeting Point

Leave carpark and turn left into Cross Street.

After passing Manor Park Home turn left into Laburnum Way.

At the T junction at the end of the road pass along the wide grassy track between bungalows and cross stile into field.

Take path across the field and pass through a kissing gate into Chester Lane.
