A summer of discovery in Wales: Aerial archaeology and the remarkable heatwave of 2018
Dr Toby Driver (RCAHMW)

The lecture is a chance to revisit the intense, hot summer of 2018 when aerial archaeology discoveries came thick and fast and when the cropmarks of Wales were - briefly - the focus of the World's press. The talk will look at the Royal Commission's major discoveries from last summer, including rarely seen examples too important to have been publicised in the national press. It will include follow-up work at key sites, and the discoveries which continue to be made during post-processing and cataloguing.
