Title: Negotiating Viking Age Furnished Burials at or near Ecclesiastical Sites in the Irish Sea Area

Speaker: Dr Danica Ramsey-Brimberg, University of Liverpool



Blurb: This lecture explores the relationship between clerics and Scandinavian-influenced laity in the Irish Sea area through the placement of furnished graves at or near ecclesiastical sites in the ninth to the eleventh centuries. Rather than be excluded, these furnished graves were an acceptable alternative among an array of burials and were the product of negotiations to establish power, wealth, and status. As a result, the relationship between the clergy and laity during the Viking Age is even more complex and closely tied than has previously been portrayed.
